City Hall Post St. Entrance Construction

Starting tomorrow, Wednesday, Oct. 25, the City Hall First Floor entry doors on Post Street will be closed for cleaning, repairing, and refinishing of the wood trim, doors, surrounds and hardware.

The contractor will be covering the exterior wood surfaces to provide weather/temperature protection, allowing work to continue in the dropping temperatures and damp weather. The historic doors will be removed, and temporary doors will be installed to ensure the building remains secure. The interior door area will also be tented to limit noise, dust, and smells while the work is being completed.

There will be no access through this entryway until the work is complete. It is anticipated that this will take approximately two weeks. The Spokane Falls Boulevard doors shall remain open and accessible during this time.

Once the work is completed on the Post Street doors, the Contractor will transition to the Spokane Falls Boulevard entry doors to complete the repair and refinishing of that entryway.
